- 1) Jill Wells & Hande Alparslan Treasurer Report
 - Tax report tax accountant is helping us sign and submit the forms.
 - Had a meeting with treasurers around the district. We are looking into investing our "nest egg".
 - Can speak with our bank for ways to invest without risk.
 - One last push for end of year donations for tax reasons. May consider a smaller amount (Wendy and Rose can decide on the amount) to ask for those who haven't participated yet.
 - We can communicate this as a separate message.
 - We can include a visual to add to the pulse where the money they are donating will be going to.
 - CAS photos from the events can be used while mentioning approximately how much these events cost
 - As we are a non-profit organization, we can share the total amount being spent to bring in all these events.
 - We can include a pie chart to show the big chunk going to CAS.
 - Liz will draft an email and loop in CAS, Presidents, Treasurers for review, to be sent sometime next week apart from the Pulse.
- 2) Carolyn Kornwitz Creative Arts & Sciences
