- 1) Jill Wells & Hande Alparslan Treasurer Report
 - We reached over the budgeted goal. Still try to get company matches if you can! It'll be added as a reminder.
 - Fall Fest did great! All expenses are in and netted about \$1500. Made a lot of money but also spent a lot more because it was bigger this year.
 - No PayPal fees anymore. Recognized as charity for PayPal.
 - Sprague Care: There's some money in the budget to spend in the community but also think about community support.
 - Reminder: online form for check requests and reimbursements on Sprague PTO website under treasury but can still be submitted in person at the office although online is quick and simple!
 - We're finally refunded for bank service fee charges.
 - Preliminary annual budget by laws is approved.
 - Compared to last year our spend has not changed.
 - We increased the budget for CAS and for field trips.
 - Key changes in budget was to add books (independently chosen especially for 5th grade, to complement what they're learning).
 - Line item for landscaping is not budgeted, not covered by the town. We need cleanup for general grounds, mulching, flowers etc.
 - We opted for no water delivery. Have looked into what other schools are doing such as filtration, discretionary funds is kept for water delivery for school but it is pretty expensive.
 - Metco budget stayed the same.

- We can focus more on Stem workshops parents with various professions host a workshop before school. Only a bit of money is needed to make it happen as cost involved would be very minimal, parents would just give their time. We need someone to lead this?
- Currently we are running a significant deficit and won't be covering our cost. This year we are at 27k deficit assuming we use it all up. This will be our second year with a deficit, unless we do an in-person auction.
- We can share the budget approved as is and so far it's in good shape as is.
