 - Book Fair: \$3230.72 profit from sales of over \$13,000 Online sales are not included and will be specified by Oct 15th
 - Annual Appeal & 5th Grade Fund: 35% of total students donated for Annual Appeal so far.
 100% of students donated for 5th Grade Fund.
 - Spiritwear: \$600 from cash and PayPal/Venmo
 - o Fall Fest: Around \$450 worth of tickets have sold so far
 - Sprague Cares: It is a fund that we allocate for the community that is district wide for families in need. Every school has its own way to allocate the funds, working with other schools on formalizing a yearly process for Sprague Cares Program.

- PayPal: Working on defining Sprague PTO as a charity in PayPal to be able to avoid most of the processing fees.
- Online Donations: We've fixed a double-counting issue with the online donation form and will be emailing those that have already donated to inform them. They can request a refund for the excess.
